- Their display in our Cathedral allows for "Visual Immersion" which enhances the overall experience of the Divine Liturgy and allows us to teach our children the gospel through our icons.

Fundraising Update



Overall fundraising need is \$2.3M - Which includes paying off existing debt

- Assumes ~\$400K in existing pledges
- Raising in tranches for additional iconography phases

\$400K of the \$2.3M has been secured as of March 19th

We want widespread participation from parishioners to reach our goal.

<u>Pledges can be paid out now or spread out over up to three</u> <u>years and four installments</u>
